Riders getting heart palpitations or shortness of breath 6. Riders getting claustrophobic 7. Riders feeling faint from riding on empty stomach 8. Site visitors or animals entering perimeter fence

Sharp and/or hard edges on vehicles' open doors 2. Long untied shoelaces on riders' shoes 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1, 2 & 7. Nightfall decreasing visibility 5. Humid weather making riders uncomfortable and reducing fresh airflow
RISK MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES	NORMAL OPERATION	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Supervisors closely control and observe visitor movement in station 3. Supervisors instruct riders using steps to anticipate 'jelly legs' 4. Supervisors ensure that riders secure loose shoelaces 5 & 6. Supervisors carefully explain race format and braking procedures 7. Supervisors look for signs of overexertion or faintness in riders 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sharp edges are clearly marked 2. Trip hazards are clearly marked 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1, 2 & 7. Supervisors turn on lights before dusk to improve visibility
